What is VINE?

VINE is an automated service that provides inmate custody status from county jails and the Department of Corrections, as well as probation and parole. Victims, law enforcement and the general public have continuous access to vital information over the phone or internet.

Learn how to sign up, or help someone else sign up, to be notified of a change in status. Learn about phone, text message and email notifications.

What is VINE VPO?

VINE VPO is an automated service that notifies victims when their VPO has been served, giving them an added tool in their safety plan.

This service is a great benefit to victims...but, only if they are informed. You can help! This workshop covers information vital to victims of crime, so bring as many people as you wish. **All training's are from 1pm – 4pm.**
