- Brandy Winget apprised the committee that Fleet Management has now had two (2) Chevrolet Impalas converted to dedicated compressed natural gas. One of the Impalas is a 2009 and that kit is still being tested in order to receive the EPA certification. This vehicle has an Automatic Vehicle Location (AVL) equipment that the EPA will be able to dial into in order to read the emissions for the On Board Diagnostics II (OBDII). Hopefully this will allow this kit to be certified sooner.

**V. Committee Reports:**

- Jim Taylor stated that Tulsa Public Schools are in the progress of re-powering 120 buses to operate on CNG. This re-powering will depend on the bond issue and will actually be 60 – 80 buses now.
