Please see listed below the questions received and the answers for this RFP

Q1. I read in the contract, under invoicing, that payment would be made in "arrears" after delivery and inspection. We would like to receive payment immediately after the product is inspected and accepted. Can we stipulate this on the bid?

A1. The State cannot tell you what you can or cannot put on the bid. Any additional information stated by vendors is part of the evaluation. The State doesn't pay "immediately" – claims have to be processed, etc. after inspection and acceptance. In the General Provisions there is an avenue to collect interest if the State pays later than 45 days.

Q2. May we supply one (1) completed unit a time (every 60 days) or do you require pick-up and delivery of all three (3) units at one time.

A2. DOC does not require pick-up and delivery of all three units at one time. Supplying one (1) completed unit every 60 days would be OK.
