RFP Clarification for Announcing Science Standards Framework Project

The Oklahoma State Department of Education is seeking K-12 classroom educators to participate in the development of the Oklahoma Science Standards Framework. The Oklahoma Science Standards Framework will provide educators with information and resources to develop their own curriculum aligned to the Oklahoma Academic Standards for Science. The framework will not serve as curriculum itself. The Oklahoma Science Standards Framework will be modeled from a similar resource developed in Minnesota (the Minnesota Mathematics and Science Standards Framework (see link <http://www.scimathmn.org/stemtc/>)).

The Science Standards Framework Project is being facilitated through a sealed bid process by the Office of Management and Enterprise, Central Purchasing Division. In a contracting process, the entity seeking the work of the project develops the parameters and deliverable of a contract. This information is presented in a Request for Proposal (RFP) from which the PO/Contract will be issued. Individuals wishing to submit a proposal go through a process similar to submitting an application. If you would like to be a part of the process to assist the State Department of Education in developing the Science Framework, you will need to go to the website (listed below), click on the link and the page will open showing all RFP's and solicitations that are open. Scroll through the list and find RFP 2650000297 and click on the bid number. The RFP will open up and you can either save it to your computer or print the document.

Below you will find a little more helpful information explaining some components of the [solicitation](#).

On the 2nd page of the RFP, 4. Oklahoma Sales Tax Permit. This permit is meant for companies that sale products/services in the State of Oklahoma. Teachers wanting to participate in this RFP must call the Oklahoma Tax Commission to inquire if you need a Oklahoma Sales Tax Permit and number and if you don't, they will explain to you why. Teachers will need to check NO – Exempt pursuant to Oklahoma Laws or Rules. You will need to call to verify that you do not need this.

Also on page 2. 5. Registration with the Oklahoma Secretary of State. Call the number listed . They will inform you if you need to register or not and if not, give you specific details for the exemption which **must** be attached to the RFP.

6. Workers Compensation Insurance Coverage. The following applies only to current teachers. Click on the link below and a waiver form will open up. Fill it out and submit it with your response.
