Description of Amendment:

a. This is to incorporate the following:

Below is one question that was left out on the first Amendment. Be Sure to have both Amendments signed and dated and returned with your bid.

Q.1. We interpret that grouting will be required for all borings as the method of plugging due to OWRB rules which state that grouting is required "If contaminated soil or groundwater is encountered in the boring, or if the boring is located at an underground storage tanks site..." Unless OVM screening is allowed as a criteria to determine whether contaminated soil is present, the first part of the criteria cannot be known while onsite. But it seems all of these sites will be located at underground storage tanks sites and therefore grouting is required. Please confirm that our interpretation is correct or whether other methods of plugging are acceptable.

A.1. Standard plugging requirements for borings that comply with Oklahoma Water Resources Board (OWRB) regulations will apply (OAC 785:35-11-2). The cost for plugging all borings in accordance with these standards should be included in the bids.
