**ADDENDUM 1 TO
STATE OF OKLAHOMA CONTRACT WITH VIDEO REALITY, INC.
RESULTING FROM SOLICITATION NO. 0900000309**

This Addendum 1 (“Addendum”) is an Amendment to the Contract awarded to Video Reality, Inc. (“Video Reality”) in connection with Solicitation 0900000309 (“Solicitation”) and is effective 11-20, 2018.

Recitals

Whereas, the State issued a Solicitation for proposals to provide audio video technology systems for the design, acquisition, installation, training, and ongoing support of audiovisual and instructional technologies;

Whereas, the State and Video Reality have negotiated the final terms under which Video Reality will perform the Services under the Contract.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual promises set forth herein, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged the parties agree as follows:

1. Addendum Purpose.

This Addendum memorializes the agreement of the parties with respect to negotiated terms of the Contract that is being awarded to Video Reality as of even date with execution of this Addendum. The parties agree that Supplier has not yet begun performance of work contemplated by the Solicitation.

2. Negotiated Documents of the Contract.

2.1. The parties have negotiated certain terms of the Contract as follows:

- i. certain clarifications to the Solicitation response as follows:
 - a. product and service warranties shall be for a period of one year after delivery or installation;
 - b. payment terms are net 45; and
 - c. goods sold will not be taken back or exchanged after acceptance by State without written consent by Video Reality.

- 2.2. Accordingly, any reference to a Contract Document refers to such Contract Document as it may have been amended. If and to the extent any provision is in multiple documents and addresses the same or substantially the same subject matter but does not create an actual conflict, the more recent provision is deemed to supersede earlier versions.
