Scope of Work

Sidewalk Expansion Joints And Curb Sealing

1.0 Statement of Needs

- 1.1 The Oklahoma History Center is in need to replace the sealant in sidewalk expansion joints.
- 1.2 Because of the enormous amount of sidewalks at the Oklahoma History Center, they have been divided into four different areas. Please enter a bid on each area separately, then a bid if contracted for the whole project.

2.0 Statement of Work

- 2.1 Only joints having sealant in them or are in obvious need has been included in this scope of work.
 - 2.1.1 All expansion joints must be sound, dry, mechanically cleaned, free of old sealant, oil, grease and any other dirt & debris.
 - 2.1.2 The void must be filled with grout or other solid fill material and resealed with a high performance, self-leveling silicone sealant.
 - 2.1.3 Sealant shall be applied according to manufacturer's specifications.
- 2.2 **AREA #1**; Begins at the fire escape at the NW corner to the Capitol tunnel, continuing to the dock access entrance. Crossing to sidewalk on south side of gated parking area. All joints and curbside must be filled. This area totals 824 linear feet.
- 2.3 **AREA #2**; Autocourt including the statue, handicap parking area and sidewalks to the Liberty Bell. This totals 1,483 linear feet.
- 2.4 **AREA #3**; Sidewalks from the Liberty Bell east on the south side of the parking lot, including sidewalks going south to access the Red River Journey, continuing across the entrance to the Oil and Gas Park and west through the 14 Flags Plaza. This area totals 1,238 linear feet.
- 2.5 **Area #4**; Red River Journey from SE corner of building to Laird. This area totals 1,430 linear feet.
- 2.6 Total of all areas 4,863 linear feet.

3.0 Warranty

- 3.1 There shall be a minimum of a five year warranty provided with contract. Any warranty provided longer than five years will be given extra weight in the selection process.
- 3.2 Warranty shall cover labor and product.
