### Description of Amendment:

a. This is to incorporate the following:

Section C.2.11 is being added to the solicitation. Section C.2.11: Specific pickup dates and times for each county health department are TBD, once awarded.

Oklahoma City-County Health Department and Tulsa-County Health Department are being omitted from the list of health departments covered in this BID.

Below is answers to questions received:

Q.1. Does Section C.2.7 and Section C.2.8. imply that the requirements of the packaging require an inner box, as well as "overpack" packaging of the inner box?

A.1. CHS would prefer to be consistent with PHL contract. We would prefer a hard red container which is reusable with a red heavy duty bag inner container that waste is placed in and then sent for incineration.

Q.2. Will decontamination by chemical be acceptable? Section B.8. reference implies decontamination by autoclave the only acceptable method.

A.2. Autoclave is the only acceptable method.

Q.3. Attachment 2: Is this an "all or none" bid? The far left column of attachment to states "can provide service as requested (Y/N). This leads me to believe that the contractor only chooses the areas that would be cost effective to the state as related to location of the contractor. Please confirm.

A.3. This is an ALL OR NON BID.

Q.4. Its asking for Biomedical Waste removal and Refuse waste removal. Is this a combine requests or can it vetted by specialty?

A.4. This is a combined request.

Q.5. Can you confirm the correct contract dates for this solicitation?

A.5. Due to the processing time for this BID, the dates coincide with when the BID ends. This is a multi-year contract.
