This Solicitation is a Contract Document and is a request for proposal in connection with the Contract awarded by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs as more particularly described below. Any defined term used herein but not defined herein shall have the meaning ascribed in the General Terms or other Contract Document.

PURPOSE

The Contract is awarded on behalf of the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs for relief pharmacist services for all seven (7) Veterans Centers across the State.

1. Contract Term and Renewal Options

The initial Contract term, which begins on the effective date of the Contract, is one year and there are four (4) one-year options to renew the Contract.

2. Contract Specifications

A. Obligations of Supplier:

- a. Provide relief pharmacist services to include:
 - i. Dispensing medications as order by physicians.
 - ii. Consulting with physicians as necessary.
 - iii. Checking/verifying the work of pharmacy technicians.
- b. Provide availability to work 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday thru Friday.
- c. Provide relief pharmacists for working vacation, sick, and other leave days of existing pharmacy staff at the ODVA Veterans Centers, listed:
