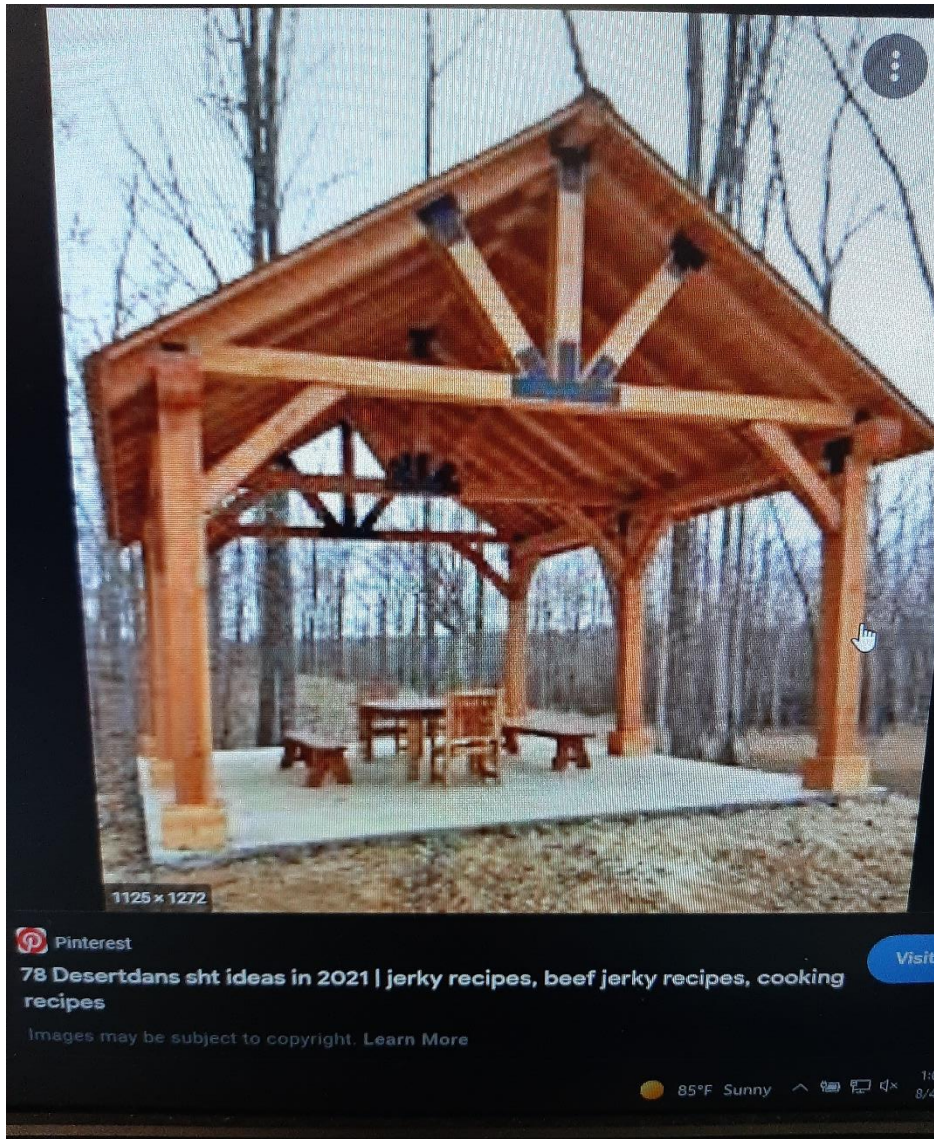

Camp Gruber Training Center Pavilion

1. **GENERAL:** This purchase/project is for **MATERIALS ONLY**. Respondents should beware that the materials provided must be both structurally sound and aesthetically pleasing. The materials provided will be installed at the main entrance gate of Camp Gruber Training Center (CGTC) which serves as a welcome center to thousands of customers each year.
2. **DELIVERY:** For the purpose of estimating shipping, the delivery location will be to Camp Gruber Training Center, 6000 Highway 10, Braggs, OK 74423. Employees will unload at site.
3. **PRODUCT SPECIFICATIONS:** Contractor shall provide all materials for a wooden post and beam pavilion with a green metal roof. The pavilion will be installed by CGTC employees to an existing concrete slab. CGTC will select one (1) Supplier from the respondents to provide materials. Materials provided should provide CGTC a turn-key product for installation. Specifications are as follows:
 - a. Wood Pavilion must have 6in x 6in posts, with a post height of 9 foot.
 - b. Outside post spacing must be 18ft x 12ft with a roof size of 24ft x 16ft.
 - c. Materials and Hardware must be pre-drilled and cut ready to assemble.
 - d. Wood Grade will be Cedar, Redwood, or Douglas-fir.
 - e. Transparent premium sealant shall be included by the manufacturer.
 - f. Will include a ready to install hunter green metal roof with trim
 - g. Fascia Board and Gutters required.
 - h. Post decorative trim to cover anchors must be included.
 - i. Manufacturer recommended post anchor kit for 6" concrete slab required.
 - j. Prior to award, selected contractor must supply drawings and detailed installation instructions for review and acceptance by agency. Award is contingent on agency acceptance.
- 3.1 **This is a firm fixed price bid.** Delivery of product must be within 90 days from the Notice to Proceed.
- 3.2 **Contractor is responsible** to ensure that Pavilion meets all applicable and current international and national building codes.
4. **FINAL PRODUCT REFERENCE:** The pavilion may be either purchased from a manufacturer or fabricated off-site and prepared for installation by CGTC employees. An image of an acceptable pavilion for design reference is located below.



5. **WORKMANSHIP:** Provided materials shall be in accordance with recommendations of the manufacturer using standard trade practices.

6. **DAMAGE TO PERSONAL PROPERTY:** The contractor shall be responsible for all damage to Government and personal property caused by the negligent acts or omissions of his/her employees, subcontractors, or agents during contract performance/delivery.

7. **DRAWING SUBMITTALS:** Selected contractor must provide submittals containing both product data and assembly instructions/drawings prior to award for review of submittals and acceptance by agency. Award of contract is contingent on review and acceptance by agency. Contractor will have 14 calendar days from the date of agency request to provide submittal of product data and assembly instructions/drawings.

8. **DELIVERIES:** The contractor shall schedule and be on-site for all material deliveries required as a part of this purchase. Deliveries must be scheduled for Tuesday – Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

9. **IF UPON RECEIPT OF MATERIALS** it is determined that the product is not acceptable, the contractor shall correct the deficiency and notify the Department of Public Works (DPW) when he/she feels that the desired material is located and/or received.

10. **PAYMENT:** Payments shall be made according to contract documents.
