

**STATE OF OKLAHOMA STATEWIDE CONTRACT WITH CAROLINA
BIOLOGICAL SUPPLY COMPANY**

This State of Oklahoma Statewide Contract (“Contract”) N. SW1072 is entered into between the state of Oklahoma by and through the Office of Management and CAROLINA BIOLOGICAL SUPPLY COMPANY. (“Supplier”) and is effective as of the date of last signature to this Contract. The initial Contract term, which begins on the effective date of the Contract, is one (1) year and there are four (4) one-year options to renew the Contract.

Purpose

This Non-Mandatory Statewide Contract is awarded for Science, Technology, Engineering & Math (STEM) related educational tools and products for ages K-12, and Higher Education, as more particularly described in certain Contract Documents found herein. This contract will be made available to all levels of the state, local and county government agencies as well as other public agencies authorized to utilize statewide contracts. A contract may be awarded to one or more suppliers.

This Contract memorializes the agreement of the parties with respect to negotiated terms of the Contract that is being awarded to Supplier.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual promises set forth herein, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged the parties agree as follows:

1. The parties agree that Supplier has not yet begun performance of work under this Contract. Upon full execution of this Contract, Supplier may begin work. Issuance of a purchase order is required prior to payment to a Supplier.
