1. **CURRENT CRIME**-Ineligible if any current incarceration crime is found in subsection E of 57 O.S. Section 138 (Attachment O, OP-060211). If an ineligible sentence is found, it is not necessary to complete sections 2 and 3. Mark section 4 "No" indicating offender is ineligible for Enhanced Levels 3 and 4. List at least one ineligible crime (offense title, case #, county, State, if other than Oklahoma):
