# EDUCATION

- Oklahoma Department of Corrections is accredited through the State Department of Education and AdvandEd (formerly NCA CASI and SACS now combined).
- 74 education personnel (teachers, administrators) with 44 vacancies.
- 66% of our educators have a masters' degree or higher.
- Average teaching experience of teachers is more than 24 years.
- Students spent 688,031 hours last year in literacy, ABE and GED classes.
- 84% pass rate on the GED last year, which is higher than Oklahoma's pass rate, and Oklahoma's is higher than the national average.
- Affiliated with 9 universities and colleges to provide college classes both to staff and offenders.
- 30 associate degrees this year

- 2 bachelor degrees
- Savings to the Department through achievement credits earned in the three basic programs: literacy, ABE and GED equate to approximately \$7,574,675.
