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Division of Probation and Parole/Community Sentencing

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The Oklahoma Community Service Sentencing Program has been in effect since November 1, 1988. The statutory provisions are found in Title 22, Section 981a-4. The purpose of the program is “to provide an alternative to incarceration for nonviolent felony offenders who would normally be sentenced to incarceration in a state institution.”

The Department of Corrections is authorized to contract with counties, subject to funds from the legislature, in Title 22, Section 991.a-2. During fiscal year 2001, forty-five counties contracted with the Department of Corrections for these local programs.

To compile information for this report, all contracted counties are requested to submit summary information regarding their program activities for the contract period. This information is outlined throughout this report.

The Community Service Sentencing Program enabled contracting counties to complete numerous projects benefiting the local community. Many of these projects would not have been possible without the labor provided to the counties through the program. The total annual labor cost savings reported by the contracting counties was \$887,397.16.

The majority of the county contract funds are utilized to establish and maintain local community service work programs. Contract monies are also utilized for personnel to establish and monitor local projects and for materials and equipment necessary to operate the program.


Alternative Confinement in the County Jail

Under the alternative confinement portion of the statute, the judge may order the offender to confinement in the county jail in lieu of imprisonment in a state facility for nights or weekends for up to one year. The Department of Corrections reimburses county sheriffs incarceration costs for eligible offenders. The reimbursement is not to exceed \$20 per day. During fiscal year 2001, fifty-seven counties participated under this provision of the statute for a total cost of \$1,805,970.





**FY 2000 versus 2001**




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
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




## Hours Assigned versus Hours Completed




### COMMUNITY SERVICE SENTENCING PROGRAM Hours Assigned versus Hours Completed







**Sentenced to Alternative Confinement**




COMMUNITY SERVICE SENTENCING PROGRAM

 Number of Offenders FY00 versus FY01





Number of Offenders FY00 versus FY01




