Why change?

- Safe Kids Worldwide, NHTSA and the CPS Board felt obligated to respond to the technician outcry to get rid of online exam
- Benefits families
- CEUs enable you to stay current in the field at your own pace
- Personal choice (lots of CEU options)

Getting rid of the online exam?

- Some people are just good test takers and may not be current while others are very active and poor test takers.
- Concern over the relevance of the test to field work
 - Included questions about FMVSS
 - Did not include questions about new products on the market

The certification cycle for both technicians and instructors is two years. In order to retain your certification, you must meet all of the requirements for and successfully complete the re-certification process.

There are two general steps to successful re-certification:

1. Meet all pre-registration requirements, including:
 1. Verified seat check activity (5 types)
 2. Community event (one check up or community workshop)
 3. Continuing education (6 hours)
 4. If applicable, teaching hours.
2. Register and pay for re-certification (this may be done up to four months prior to your certification cycle end date)

The re-certification fee is \$40 for technicians and instructor candidates and \$60 for instructors. If a certified individual is selected for audit and does not pass, no refund will be provided. A detailed fee table is available in Resources->Fees.

PLEASE NOTE: The re-certification process cannot be completed in a single day. Depending upon the choices you make, the process could take as few as five days to as many as 60 days to complete

Eligibility

Technicians and Instructor Candidates

1. Have a current certification
2. Have a minimum of one of each of the five required seat checks logged in the system and verified by a certified instructor
3. Community event (one check up or community workshop) logged in the system
4. Continuing education logged in the system (6 hours)

Instructors

1. Meet eligibility requirement of technicians and instructor candidates
2. Have a minimum of 20 teaching hours logged in the system, at least 10 of which are from teaching the certification course

2007 Recertification Requirements


Basic re-certification requirements and deadlines

1. Five (5) seat checks approved by a certified instructor (may use technician proxy option)
2. Community Education
3. A minimum of six hours of CPS technical continuing education (CEUs)
4. Register and pay fee by the end of the certification expiration date.

INSTRUCTORS: In addition to the above requirements, you must also log 20 teaching hours of CPS course instruction.

5 Seat Checks

Same as

- These may be done at any time during your certification cycle.
- Seat checks are entered online AND approved by an instructor
 - Rear-facing infant child safety seat
 - Rear-facing convertible child safety seat
 - Forward-facing child safety seat with harness
 - Belt-positioning booster
 - Installation with LATCH

Community Event

New!

- **PICK ONE**
 - **Participate in at least one two-hour check up event**
 - With at least one other CPS Technician
 - Using any standardized checklist to provide documentation, if needed.
 - **Provide at least four hours of community education.**
 - Examples include presenting to parents, educators, kids, organizations (PTAs, law enforcement).
 - These are presentations to non-CPSTs.

Continuing Education (CEU)

- A minimum of six hours of CPS technical continuing education (CEUs) must be obtained and reported during one's current certification cycle (two years).
- They may be entered at any time during your certification cycle (once programming is done in January 2007)
- CEUs must fit into one of the five approved categories and meet content requirements.

What is a CEU?

- CEU = Continuing Education Units
- Generally, one hour of technical contact time counts for one Continuing Education Unit (CEU).
 - 3/4 hr (45 min) - 1 hr 15 min = 1 CEU
 - 1 hr 15 min - 1 hr 45 min = 1.5 CEUs
 - 1 hr 45 min - 2 hr 15 min = 2 CEUs
 - You may NOT combine shorter sessions
- Mix and match to get your 6 CEUs (workshops, teleconferences, quizzes)

Continuing Education

Categories of CEUs

1. In-person Session/Workshop (max 6 CEUs)
2. Observing a CPS Certification or Renewal Course (max 3 CEUs)
3. Teleconferences (max 5 CEUs)
4. Online/Web sessions (max 5 CEUs)
5. Newsletters/Manuals/Journals (max 3 CEUs)

Content Requirements

- All categories of CEUs must meet the **content requirements** of improving CPS technical knowledge

Examples of content that would qualify for CEUs

- ✓ CR manufacturer workshops/product updates
- ✓ CPS Q& A panel at a conference
- ✓ Vehicle manufacturer workshops specific to occupant protection
- ✓ The latest LATCH technology
- ✓ Case studies of child occupants in crashes
- ✓ Car seats and school bus safety
- ✓ Restraining tweens

Examples of content that would NOT qualify for CEUs

- ✘ How to run an inspection station
- ✘ Cultivation and retention of CPS Technicians
- ✘ Using data to dissect the CPS problem
- ✘ Impaired driving victim impact panel
- ✘ Older drivers
- ✘ How to use the national CPS certification online system
- ✘ Children around cars/Spot the Tot
- ✘ Tips on how to better teach your CPS Cert. Class
- ✘ Operation Kids courses (*subsets of certification course*)

Can a CPS workshop I attended last year count?

The educational sessions must be within your current certification cycle and meet approved content areas.

- If your certification cycle is 7/1/2005-6/30/2007
 - A session was in November of 2006, it would qualify for credit under category #1.
 - A session taken in June of 2005 would not qualify.

Getting 6 CEUs

- Mix and match to get the 6 hours at any time during your certification cycle
- No need to rely on an instructor!
 - Complete LATCH or CRMI quizzes
 - Read the Tech Update
 - Organize a trip to CR retailer to learn about new seats
 - Organize a teleconference or meeting

Example: Mix-n-match

- Read Tech Update → 1 CEU
- Complete LATCH Quiz → 1 CEU
- Attend 2 hour technical update → 2 CEUs
- Attend new CR test run at local retailer for 2 hours → 2 CEUs



Non-technical CPS sessions, such as how to get funding or run an inspection station do not qualify.


