

Name Change

Oklahoma law requires the holder of a **Oklahoma drivers license** or a **Oklahoma identification card** to notify the Department of Public Safety, **in writing, within ten (10) days**, of any change in their mailing address, residential address, county of residence, or name change.

If your current name is different from your identification documents you must provide a Primary ID and Secondary ID and show how the name was changed or is going to be changed.

Primary ID (Usually a State Certified Birth Certificate)

Secondary ID (Usually a Social Security Card)

Name change documents shall include:

- Divorce Decree
- Adoption Decree
- Name Change Decree, or
- Establishment of Record of Birth, Pursuant to **63 OS., 1-315**
- Marriage License
- For a common law marriage, "Affidavit of Common Law Marriage" containing the notarized signatures of the husband and wife. Both primary and secondary forms of identification must be submitted in addition to this affidavit.

Form of new name: Name must be the legal name as shown on the document that is changing the name.
