Voter Registration Address Confirmation Notice



What is this?

This is a Voter Registration Address Confirmation Notice from the Oklahoma State Election Board. Federal and State laws [52 USC §20507 and 26 OS §4-120.2] require us to confirm the voter registration residence addresses of some voters at least every two years.

Why did I get this? Am I in trouble?

No, you are not in trouble. You were selected to receive this notice for one or more of these reasons:

- ✓ Your voter information (name, date of birth, Oklahoma driver license number, or last four digits of your Social Security number) matches:
 - ➔ The record of another voter in Oklahoma;
 - ➔ A person who surrendered an Oklahoma driver license after receiving a new driver license in another state; or
 - ➔ A person who is registered to vote and votes in another state.
- ✓ A first-class mailing (such as a voter identification card or a voter registration application rejection notice) addressed to you was returned to the County Election Board marked "undeliverable as addressed."
- ✓ You have not voted in any election held since November 1, 2014, and you have not tried to update our voter registration during that time period.

Very Important Information

If you have moved and filed a Change of Address with the United States Post Office within the past three (3) years, this notice may have been forwarded to your current postal address. Your current postal address may **not** be the address at which you are registered to vote. Your current voter registration address is printed on the back of this notice.

Choose one of these ways to respond to this notice and confirm your voter registration address:

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1. **ONLINE:** Go to www.elections.ok.gov and choose **Online Voter Tool**.

- a. When your voter information page opens, look for "Voter Confirmation" and enter the 11-digit number above your name and address on this notice.
- b. Follow the instructions on screen. Don't mail the Return Card.

2. **BY MAIL:** Fill out the Return Card, sign and date it, fold the notice so that the State Election Board's address is on the outside. Tape the notice closed and mail it.

Frequently Asked Questions



What if I live at the address on this card, but I am not the person named? The confirmation notice is for someone who used to live at your address. Destroy this card.

What if the person named on the card is deceased? If you are a member of the deceased voter's family, contact your local County Election Board office or visit the State Election Board's website for a form you can use to cancel the voter's registration. Destroy this card.

What if I got this card but I don't live in Oklahoma any more? Return the card and tell us that, or go to our website to learn how to cancel your registration in Oklahoma.
