

Notice: Evacuation of Dewey County Election Board Due to Wildfires

Wildfires that forced the evacuation last week of the Dewey County Seat of Taloga, the location of the Dewey County Election Board, are once again threatening the town. The Dewey County Election Board has been forced to evacuate the county courthouse. Its activities, including the acceptance of candidate withdrawals and contests of candidacy, are relocating to the Major County Election Board, 500 E Broadway, Stw.8, in Fairview through 5 p.m. today. The Dewey County Election Board will continue to operate from the Major County Election Board as long as authorities deem it unsafe to return to their offices in Taloga.
