Five Judges of the Court of Civil Appeals, one from each of the following districts:

- District 3, Office 1 (unexpired term ending January 8, 2017)
- District 4, Office 1 (unexpired term ending January 8, 2017)
- District 5, Office 1 (6-year term)
- District 5, Office 2 (6-year term)
- District 6, Office 1 (6-year term)

Justices of the Oklahoma Supreme Court, Judges of the Court of Criminal Appeals and Judges of the Court of Civil Appeals will appear on a retention ballot at the General Election only. (Article 7B, Oklahoma Constitution and 20 O.S., §30.16)
