

1 **Rule 5.3. Annual Registration for Legislative Liaison and**
2 **Legislative Lobbyist.**

3 Each legislative liaison or legislative lobbyist shall be
4 required to register with the Ethics Commission each year that
5 the legislative liaison or legislative lobbyist engages in
6 lobbying. Each legislative liaison or legislative lobbyist
7 shall register or renew his or her registration with the
8 Commission and pay any applicable fees no earlier than December
9 1 of each year nor later than ~~December~~ January 31 ~~15~~ of ~~each~~ the
10 following year for the calendar year beginning ~~the following~~
11 January 1 or within five (5) days after engaging in lobbying on
12 behalf of one or more lobbyist principals ~~and pay a registration~~
13 ~~fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and an additional~~
14 ~~processing fee for using a credit card.~~ Each legislative
15 ~~liaison or legislative lobbyist may be reimbursed for the~~
16 ~~registration fee and service fee by a lobbyist principal.~~
17 Registration by legislative liaisons or legislative lobbyists
18 shall be filed electronically, unless otherwise ordered by the
19 Commission or the Executive Director of the Commission.
20 Information on the registration shall include the legislative
21 liaison or legislative lobbyist's name, business address,
22 including electronic mail address and business telephone
23 numbers, the name and address of each lobbyist principal by whom

1 the liaison or lobbyist is employed or retained and the date of
2 the registration.

3 **Rule 5.5. Annual Registration and Termination of Registration**
4 **for Executive Lobbyist.**

5 Each executive lobbyist shall be required to register with the
6 Ethics Commission. An executive lobbyist may register and pay
7 any applicable fees no earlier than December 1 of each year nor
8 later than ~~December~~ January 31 ~~15~~ of each the following year
9 for the calendar year beginning ~~the following~~ January 1 or
10 within five (5) days after engaging in lobbying on behalf of one
11 or more lobbyist principals. Registration by executive
12 lobbyists shall be filed electronically, unless otherwise
13 ordered by the Commission or the Executive Director of the
14 Commission. Information on the registration shall include the
15 executive lobbyist's name, business address, including
16 electronic mail address and business telephone numbers, the name
17 and address of each lobbyist principal by whom the lobbyist is
18 employed or retained, the agency or agencies before which the
19 lobbyist is lobbying and the date of the registration. The
20 executive lobbyist may terminate his or her registration at any
21 time by electronically filing a notice of termination on a form
22 provided by the Commission and filing a final Executive Lobbyist
23 Report. An executive lobbyist whose registration has not been
24 terminated by November 30 of any year shall be required to

1 register ~~no earlier than December 1 nor later than December 31~~
2 ~~of that year to continue his or her registration through~~
3 ~~December and~~ as provided in this subsection for the calendar
4 year beginning the following January 1. Until terminated, the
5 registration shall remain effective, and the executive lobbyist
6 shall be required to file Executive Lobbyist Reports as provided
7 by these Rules.

8 **Rule 5.19. Legislative Liaison and Legislative Lobbyist Report**
9 **Deadlines.**

10 Each legislative liaison and legislative lobbyist shall file a
11 Legislative Lobbyist Report on the following dates for the
12 following time periods:

13 1. Before the ~~sixth~~ sixteenth day of January for the period
14 beginning July 1 and ending December 31 of the preceding year.

15 2. Before the sixth day of February, March, April, May, and
16 June, and before the sixteenth day of July for the preceding
17 month.

18 Except for good cause shown, any legislative liaison or
19 legislative lobbyist who, during a calendar year, files more
20 than one Legislative Lobbyist Report after the date it is due
21 shall be deemed to have intentionally failed to file the report
22 in violation of these Rules.

23 **Rule 5.20. Executive Lobbyist Report Deadlines.**

Lobbyist

1 Each executive lobbyist shall file an Executive Lobbyist Report
2 before the ~~sixth~~ sixteenth day of January, April, July and
3 October for the preceding calendar quarter. Except for good
4 cause shown, any executive lobbyist who, during a calendar year,
5 files more than one Executive Lobbyist Report after the date it
6 is due shall be deemed to have intentionally failed to file the
7 report in violation of these Rules. An executive lobbyist who
8 also is registered as a legislative lobbyist may choose to file
9 reports as an executive lobbyist on the same dates that he or
10 she files reports as a legislative lobbyist.
