2024: Local Political Party Committee Reporting County, Congressional District & Other Non-State Level Political Party Committees

Local Party Committees are only required to file a Statement of Organization and file reports when the committee makes one or more of the following triggering events:

- (1) a contribution of any amount to a State Candidate Committee;
- (2) an Independent Expenditure (IE) as defined in Rule 2.2(10); or*
- (3) an Electioneering Communication (EC) as defined in Rule 2.2(7)*.

*An additional report may be required for (2) or (3). See the IE and EC Reporting Calendar at the bottom of the page.

Due Dates: Look at the “Calendar Quarter” column and select the quarter that includes the date of the expenditure triggering the reporting required.

1st Report of Calendar Year. The report will cover all committee activity from January 1st through the last day of the calendar quarter.

2nd and Subsequent Reports During a Calendar Year. The period covered in this report will begin with the day that follows the last date covered by the immediately preceding report (April 1, July 1, or October 1) and will end on the last day of the quarter.

Example 1: Committee X makes a contribution to candidate John Doe on May 4, 2024(triggering event). Committee X has a report due between July 1 and July 31, 2024. The report will cover all contributions and expenditures made from January 1, 2024 through June 30, 2024. No further reports are required this calendar year if no other triggering expenses are made.

On or Prior to August 12, 2024 and not previously reported	August 13 – August 15, 2024
August 13 – August 27, 2024	Next business day reporting required when making IE/ECs of \$5,000 or more in the aggregate during this period
AUGUST 27, 2024 - RUNOFF PRIMARY ELECTION	
On or Prior to October 21, 2024 and not previously reported	October 22, 2024 – October 28, 2024
October 22 – November 5, 2024	Next business day reporting required when making IE/ECs of \$5,000 or more in the aggregate during this period
NOVEMBER 5, 2024 - GENERAL ELECTION
