CHASE RANKIN/EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT:

Mr. Rankin stated that at this legislative session the Pension System will have a technical corrections bill related to Secure Act 2.0., Federal Legislation that affects the System.

Provisions include:

- 1. Required Minimum Distribution age has been changed to age 73.
- 2. Repeals the requirement to withhold insurance from the Pension System in order to receive the \$3,000 tax deduction.
- 3. The alleviation of the 10% tax penalty was approved for firefighters under the age of 50 that have 25 years of service.

Mr.. Rankin reported there was a bill to increase the volunteer multiplier.

Mr. Rankin reported that he will continue to monitor a COLA Bill.

Mr. Rankin reported that Alex Hahn has four year old twins and one of them has leukemia. Mr. Rankin asked for them to be in everyone's thoughts and prayers.
