Dear Governor Fallin:

This is in response to your April 1, 2015, request for a major disaster declaration for the State of Oklahoma as a result of tornadoes, severe storms, straight-line winds, and flooding during the period of March 25-26, 2015. You specifically requested Individual Assistance for Cleveland and Tulsa Counties and Hazard Mitigation statewide.

Based on our review of all of the information available, it has been determined that the damage from this event was not of such severity and magnitude as to be beyond the capabilities of the state, affected local governments, and voluntary agencies. Accordingly, we have determined that supplemental federal assistance is not necessary. Therefore, I must inform you that your request for a major disaster declaration is denied.

This denial may be appealed within 30 days after the date of this letter. Any appeal pursuant to 44 CFR § 206.46, along with additional information justifying the appeal, should be submitted to the President through George A. Robinson, Regional Administrator, FEMA Region VI, located at 800 North Loop 288, Denton, TX 76209-3698.
