## STATE OF OKLAHOMA

### FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

**MAY 26, 2015**

Today, May 26, 2015, President Obama issued a major disaster declaration for the State of Oklahoma triggering the release of Federal funds to help people recover from the Severe Storms, Tornadoes, Straight-line Winds, and Flooding that occurred May 5-10, 2015. Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:

Declaration Number:	FEMA-4222-DR
Incident:	Severe Storms, Tornadoes, Straight-line Winds, and Flooding
Incident Period:	May 5-10, 2015
Federal Coordinating Officer:	John Long National FCO Program
Individual Assistance (IA):	(Assistance for individuals and households):
IA-Designated Counties:	Cleveland, Grady, and Oklahoma Counties.
Hazard Mitigation (HM):	(Assistance for actions taken to prevent or reduce long term risk to life and property from natural hazards):
HM-Designated Areas:	All areas in the State of Oklahoma are eligible for assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.
OTHER:	Additional designations may be made at a later date if requested by the State and warranted by the results of further damage assessments.
