

HOW TO PREPARE FOR AN EMERGENCY

CHECK LIST

Containers:

- Keep containers on hand that will be large enough to store ALL the vaccine inventory.

Ice Packs:

- Keep enough frozen icepacks on hand at all times to use for the transport of vaccine.
- If you have frozen vaccine, you must have DRY ICE to transport it.
- Dry ice evaporates with time, so it's important to keep a watchful eye.
- Remember that keeping the cold chain is imperative.

Thermometers:

- Record the temperature when you remove the vaccine from its original storage unit.
- A thermometer must be kept in each container that has vaccine.
- Temperatures must be recorded at least twice daily until vaccine can be safely returned to its refrigeration/freezer unit.
