

# OSIIS

..... is the Oklahoma State Immunization Information System, which is a statewide immunization registry, designed to collect and maintain accurate, complete, and current immunization records for the entire population of Oklahoma. While simple to use and free of charge, it performs many functions to aid Oklahoma vaccine providers. OSIIS ....

- √ provides finger-tip access to a statewide database of patient shot records
- √ sends out recall cards when vaccinations are due
- √ tracks vaccine inventory
- √ replaces monthly written VFC reports
- √ reorders vaccine automatically
- √ gives schools view-only access to shot records
- √ prints official shot records

Since 1996, if a child is born in the state of Oklahoma, they are automatically entered into OSIIS.

Providers may access OSIIS using their existing computer through either an Internet connection or a modem connected to the phone line. OSDH representatives are available to provide system training to staff, install software, and perform initial setup of OSIIS, with no expense to the site.
