
## Safe and Equitable Foster Care Reduction Partnership Declaration

*The safety and stability of Oregon's children and their families is a social, economic and moral imperative. For these children and their families who are most vulnerable, our communities, our state agencies, and our courts each have a role to play in supporting their safety, health and well-being.*


*Although progress is being made to strengthen the juvenile dependency system and enhance community supports to prevent child abuse and neglect, the number of children entering Oregon's foster care system continues to exceed the national average. Too many children stay in foster care for long periods of time, and children of color and Native American children in Oregon continue to be over-represented in the foster care system.*

*Oregon's goal is to have urban, rural and Tribal communities where parents and families are supported to safely care for their own children - without the need for government intervention. Accordingly, the Oregon Executive and Judicial branches of government, in partnership with Casey Family Programs, hereby jointly declare the safe and equitable reduction of children in Oregon's foster care system to be among our top priorities.*


