
### SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR GETTING TO CONFERENCE

From Capitol, drive to 825 Research Parkway.  
Park. Catch Shuttle.  
Ride comfortably to conference site. Return.

Due to extremely limited parking, participant's only access to conference is via the **FREE** shuttle service. We apologize in advance for this inconvenience.

**Directions below are from the Capitol to the Parking/ Shuttle Area - Shuttle service will loop back & forth to Mini Conference (see designated times below).**

1. Go South on N Lincoln Blvd from the Capitol.
2. Turn right onto Research Pky, road curves.
3. ★ Arrive at 825 Research Parkway, Okc, Ok - Just to the north side of the restaurant building in the center of the campus.



### Shuttle Service

Will run from 12:15 - 1:30pm and from 4:30 until everyone is back. Shuttles will be coming/going as quickly as possible during this timeframe. Every effort will be made to make the wait for the next shuttle as minimal as possible.

Look for parking by finding the A-Frame sign with the name of the event - this is where the shuttle picks up. Driver will issue you a token at no charge for return trip.
