





"In February 1939, the camp site was not yet purchased. The camp committee was authorized to buy or take an option on the site, and if possible, to secure immediate possession and to recommend a plan for financing and its development. At the April board meeting, Elmer Heard reported the camp road was completed. Latrines were to be completed within one week, and the water line was being constructed. The Camp-O-Ral was scheduled for the new camp site on May 25-27." (Ray Mattoy, "Thunderbird Tracks")

75th Anniversary Camp-O-Ral for Boy Scouts will be held in conjunction with the Order of the Arrow-sponsored camp work day. There will be a variety of work projects Saturday morning to assist with and help make Will Rogers SR a place that will continue making camping memories for 75 more years. Lunch will be provided by the Order of the Arrow. That afternoon, there will be "early days" Scout camp skills demo's and games. 




