Cooling Station at American Indian Expo

The Oklahoma State Department of Health Emergency Preparedness and Response Service and Caddo County Health Department is partnering with local emergency agencies and tribal entities to provide a Hydration/Cooling Station at the 83rd Annual American Indian Exposition in Anadarko. The Expo is scheduled for August 6-9, 2014 at the Caddo County Fairgrounds

Expo visitors and participants will receive some relief from the heat with a bottle of cold water and an opportunity to cool down in an air-conditioned Western Shelter insulated tent. The cooling station will be open from 2:00 pm to 10 pm daily, and will also provide health and safety information.

Additional cooling station partners include Caddo Nation, Kiowa Tribe, City of Anadarko, City of Anadarko Emergency Management, Caddo County Emergency Management, Medical Reserve Corps, American Red Cross, Wichita and Affiliated Tribes, and the Delaware Nation.
