



Adjusting Adobe Reader XI

Rover was designed to work with Adobe X or earlier.

Now Adobe has come up with a new version (XI) and many computers automatically updated the Adobe Reader from IX or X to the new version XI.

Getting ROVER to work with XI can be a challenge.

You can keep Adobe XI on your system, Adobe Reader XI will work with ROVER and you can get it to open in a new screen, otherwise you will have to log back in every time.

Here are the steps if you want to keep Adobe Reader XI :

Open a browser, under tools – internet options – select the programs tab (“Tools” in Internet Explorer 8).

Select “Manage Add-ons”

Select “All add-ons” from the drop down (IE8, it is the left menu bar option “Show”).

Scroll to Adobe and highlight Adobe PDF Reader (the version should be 11.something) then select the disable button.

If you want to remove Adobe Reader XI and go back to version X, follow these steps:

If you want to revert to an older version and stop the system from automatically updating.....

You will need to uninstall XI then go to <http://get.adobe.com/reader/otherversions/> and download an older version.

Once installed you can go to Edit>>Preferences>>Updater>> and change the setting so that the computer does not automatically install the new updates.
