The **Bryan County Turning Point Coalition** became a Turning Point partnership in 2002. Coalition Members represent many sectors of the community that contributes to the coalition's successes and effectiveness. Serving as a role model to other counties, the BCTPC is a leader in drug, alcohol, nutrition, physical activity and tobacco initiatives and prevention strategies. In 2008, energies have also focused a Healthy Workforce, Literacy, Injury Prevention (Traffic Safety), fitness, nutrition and school health. This partnership believes in the Turning Point philosophy that only through a community-based, decision-making process where community citizens taps into their own resources, strengths, and visions is when we can effectively promote positive and sustainable

changes in the public's health and the public health system. In 2006 this coalition was awarded a Drugs Free Community Grant has had many successes with this high profile grant. In 2007 the BCTPC was awarded a Tobacco Settlement Endowment Trust (TSET) grant to address tobacco use in both Bryan and Marshall Counties. This grant is fully funded and has had many success throughout the years. For the first time in years both grants position are filled. In 2012 the coalition applied for and received Wave II Round II funding from TSET. In July of 2011 the BCTPC was awarded a (TSET) grant to address nutrition and physical activity in Bryan County. Working together the two TSET grants have been very successful with a wellness approach. In February of this year the coalition

conducted a reconnecting strategic planning event developing the following 4 priorities:
 #1 Create a Strong and Healthy Community
 #2 Strengthen Partnerships to Prepare, Establish and Sustain Strong Systems of Care Support
 #3 Promote and Educate BCTPC Purpose, and
 #4 Enhance Community/Coalition Growth and Development.
