- Encourage every school in the county to adopt a 24/7 tobacco-free policy.
- Conduct a county-wide Youth Risk Behavior Survey.
- Provide support to health conferences in Caddo County.
- Increase childhood immunization rates.
- Increase awareness of underage drinking.
- Support the Native Americans for Injury Prevention Coalition
- Support domestic violence prevention efforts and raise awareness on the related issues.
- Increase awareness of resources and services available to Caddo County residents.
