The Caddo County Interagency Coalition (CCIC) in conjunction with a grant from the Oklahoma Medical Reserve Corps (OKMRC) will host a free health fair on Wednesday, November 6, 2013, from 8 am to 2 pm at the First Methodist Church Family Center, 202 West Oklahoma in Anadarko. Participants can receive over \$250 of free screening services. Health screening includes: Lipid Profile, BS, BP and A1c. (Patient must fast from midnight the night before for the Lipid profile.)

Other screening and information booths include; Kiowa Teen Suicide Prevention, Caddo-Kiowa Technology Center, Anadarko Indian Health Center Dental Clinic, Caddo County Health Department, Children First Program, Grady Memorial Hospital Women's Imaging Center, LIVE – Physical Activity & Nutrition Program, CKTEd Caddo/Kiowa Tobacco Education, and the Oklahoma Medical Reserve Corps.
