

Local Businesses Go the Extra Mile to Prevent Underage Alcohol Sales

On April 4, Warrior Mart Convenience Store and Better Spirits Liquor Store participated in a voluntary training to help reduce underage alcohol sales in Anadarko. The Responsible Beverage Service and Sales (RBSS) training, provided by the SPF-SIG Coordinator in Caddo County and the ABLE Commission, is designed to educate store owners, managers, and clerks about laws regarding alcohol sales to minors as well as noticing signs of intoxication and how to properly check an ID.

Businesses that sell alcohol have the responsibility to make sure that they are not selling to minors. RBSS training is a great way to ensure that all employees know the laws on selling alcohol to minors and how to prevent those sales by properly checking ID. Warrior Mart and Better Spirits have shown that they are committed to the reduction of underage drinking in Caddo County by not selling alcohol to minors.
