Open Streets Set Saturdays

The blocks of Southwest C Avenue from Southwest Second through Fifth Street in downtown Lawton will be closed from 8 a.m. to noon Saturday for Open Streets Lawton-Fort Sill.

The event is sponsored by the Fit Kids of Southwest Oklahoma Coalition and the City of Lawton. The cordoned-off roads will be turned into a temporary public park for the community of Lawton to enjoy. A multitude of organizations will sponsor various activities in four different zones: active, relax, chill and play.

There is no cost to attend the event and there are no age restrictions. Attendees are encouraged to take their bikes, roller blades, skateboards and dogs (as long as they're on leashes) anything to get them active.

The Lawton Farmer's Market will set up shop at Open Streets instead of the Comanche County Fairgrounds. The market will open at its usual time of 7:30 a.m.
