Downtown Park Topic Of Meeting

A meeting to gather suggestions for a new downtown park is scheduled for 5:30 p.m. Monday in the banquet room at City Hall, Southwest 9th Street and C Avenue.

The Lawton Urban Renewal Authority purchased the former gas station at Southwest 2nd Street and C Avenue as part of its efforts to spruce up downtown.

Kyle Rogers, community program coordinator for the Fit Kids Coalition of Southwest Oklahoma, said the coalition and City Planner Richard Rogalski will be facilitators for the meeting to gather suggestions on how the property should be used.

“From there we will develop a survey based on their comments and send that out to the entire community to allow anyone that wasn’t able to attend on Monday a chance to provide input,” she said. When that information is collected, it will be given to the city, the Lawton Enhancement Trust Authority, Lawton Urban Renewal Authority and others to incorporate into an overall design plan.
