According to James T Smith, who spoke at the LeFlore County Principals meeting at KTC in Poteau bullying has expanded to so many different methods. "It's not just big boy picking on the little boy," said Smith. County and state schools lose daily attendance due to Bullying. And lives are ruined forever that can spread to the next generation when a child has been bullied during their life.

The Bullying Awareness Project hopes to bring the message of awareness that will spread with the result of all children soon knowing that they don't have to be bullied in school, at work or at home and that they can ask for help without being harmed.

Smith told the principals that the coalition would like to discuss a cooperative partnership with the local schools, by conducting a survey as well as helping to create a "Safe Place" which will provide a safe place for children whenever they feel threatened.
