Prague—Residents will be able to dispose of excess and expired prescription and over-the-counter medications at the Prague Police Department starting this week. The Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control will install a disposal box Friday in the police department lobby. It will be accessible 24 hours a day. Needles and liquids won't be accepted. The drop box installation is part of an effort led by police and the Prague Turning Point Coalition to reduce the supply of drugs in the community that are potentially harmful to teens and adults.
