Sallisaw NOW and Sequoyah County Sheriff Department have teamed up to provide an anonymous HOTLINE number for students or adults to use without the worry of being identified. They can call or text and the number will not show up.

This will be for reporting the eyewitness account or knowledge of unlawful drug use, drug selling or other crimes that are being committed.

Sheriff Ron Lockhart said, "This is something that we had when I worked in other counties and it is especially for the youth at school. We will have a team that will work on the calls that are received and I believe it can help us stop many of the crimes that are going unnoticed. It is a project that I have wanted to start for a long time so I am happy that Sallisaw NOW has joined with me to help with this community challenge."
