## Trail Run, Okiefest Promise Good Time Saturday In Frederick

FREDERICK—Frederick and Tillman County will be bustling Saturday with the second annual Wagon Wheel Trail Run and first Okiefest Music Festival.

The Wagon Wheel Trail Run will be at Lake Frederick, east of Manitou. This year's event will begin with packet pick-up from 8-9:15 a.m. The packets can also be picked up in advance from 1-5 p.m. Friday at Crawford Abstract.

The run will begin at 10 a.m. It will include the 5K that's been a part of past events, along with a new 14K run. Both will include parts of the Lake Frederick Trail. Also included are free activities for children and a concession stand. Registration is \$25 for the 5K and \$50 for the 14K. The race is part of the Fitness in Action series in Southwest Oklahoma and sponsored by the Frederick Chamber of Commerce and the Tillman County Youth and Community Coalition.
