This legislation was enacted due to cosmetic reasons and the growing need for medical micropigmentation in the treatment of clinical conditions or traumas such as cancer, surgery, and burns.

Individuals wishing to perform medical micropigmentation must enroll in an approved Oklahoma State Department of Health (OSDH) Medical Micropigmentation Training Program before entering the certification testing process. Contact an OSDH-approved training center to find out when the next course begins. There are six approved training centers:

Upon successful completion of approved training, the applicant is eligible to request an application by contacting OSDH. When completing the application, please check off the items listed below to ensure you have supplied all pertinent information. Please return this page to OSDH with your completed application, including the following:

- Application signed
- Application dated
- Certification fee of \$515.00 (\$500.00 application fee + \$15.00 OSBI fee)
- Applicant must be at least 21 years of age
- High school diploma or equivalent

Pursuant to Title 49 O.S., Section 118 of the Oklahoma Statutes, all documents requiring notarization must contain: date of notary, notary's signature, seal, commission number, and expiration date. These include:

- Notarized copy of applicant's certificate of birth
- Notarized copy of applicant's driver's license or similar photo identification
- Notarized copy of credentials and resume documenting years of practice and number of procedures performed

In addition, an OSBI background check will be completed pursuant to section 63-1-1454 of the Act.

OSDH, upon satisfactory completion of all of the above qualifications, will issue a letter of notification informing the student and Career Tech that they are eligible to test. Career Tech will then notify the student when and where certification testing will take place.

The applicant is eligible to apply for a Medical Micropigmentation Certificate upon successful completion of the certification testing process (skills area evaluations, written certification test, and clinical skills test) and providing proof to OSDH of satisfactory completion (Completed Training and Testing Verification Form) from the OSDH-approved Career Tech Medical Micropigmentation Testing Program. The State Commissioner of Health shall process for certification as set forth in Section 5 of the Act. If approved, a certificate will be issued within 30 days of receipt of completed application and completed training and testing Verification Forms.
