Key Activities:

- Partnered with OSU Ext - hosted *Farm to You*, 40'x40' walk-through exhibit that teaches children about healthy nutrition
- Supported CKTed efforts to promote 24/7 Tobacco-Free policy in schools/businesses
- Promoted leadership events (e.g., SWAT and 2M 2L) to local youth
- Promotion of Social Host Ordinance
- Promoted 1-800-QuitNow Hotline

Significant Outcomes:

- ◆ Supported statewide efforts to reduce infant mortality/improve birth outcomes.
- ◆ Ongoing partnership with Caddo-Kiowa Tobacco Education (CKTed).
- ◆ Supported *Prevention & Recovery 77 Initiative* (Prevention & Treatment for addictive disorders).
- ◆ Collaboration with Wind Hollow Foundation to secure grant funding to refurbish abandoned buildings; promote economic development in Anadarko.
