The Caddo County Interagency Coalition (CCIC) has been an official Turning Point Partner since 2003. The establishment of the coalition was intended to facilitate information sharing and resource networking between county residents. The original group of coalition members was constituted of concerned citizens interested in cataloging all of the services that were available in their county and then developing innovative strategies to increase public awareness about those available services.

Today, along with the goal of maintaining and promoting an up-to-date resource guide, CCIC has committed to realizing a healthier future for Caddo County children and youth through the support of impactful programming and the implementation of effective policies that encourage good health. With respect to this commitment, CCIC partnered with the Kiowa County Coalition to successfully respond to two requests for proposals from the Tobacco Settlement Endowment Trust: CCIC is now a coalition
