ACUTE DISEASE

The purpose is to control communicable disease through surveillance for infectious diseases; investigation of disease outbreaks; analysis of data to plan, implement and evaluate disease prevention and control measures; dissemination of pertinent information; education of healthcare professionals and the public; and bioterrorism preparedness.

CHILD GUIDANCE

Staff provides services that fall into four general categories: services to individual children and families (birth to age 13); education services to the general population; services to professionals; and community development.

CHILDREN FIRST

Program provides home visits to first-time parents to encourage their ability to care for themselves. It encourages early and continuous prenatal care, healthy infant & child development, and the involvement of fathers and other supportive people.

CONSUMER HEALTH

The Consumer Protection Division is responsible for licensing, monitoring and inspecting hotels and motels, eating and drinking establishments, retail food outlets and public bathing places. Staff also investigates standing water complaints, rabies exposure, and other health nuisance complaints.



EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

The public health and medical systems are critical infrastructure and vital support functions in the event of an emergency. The health department works diligently to address the public health implications of a large-scale disaster affecting the county's population. These efforts are done in partnership with local, state, and federal partners.

FAMILY PLANNING

Staff provides comprehensive reproductive health services for males and females. For females, services include physical exams including pap smears and breast exams, screening for sexually transmitted infections, information on the different contraceptive methods available, pregnancy diagnosis and counseling, and referrals. For males services include physical exams, screening for sexually transmitted infections, education and counseling on prevention of pregnancy and sexually transmitted infections, access to condoms, and testicular exams when needed.

HIV/STD

Program concentrates on screening, diagnosing, educating, treating, individual case management, and referral services for those at increased risk for sexually transmitted infections.



IMMUNIZATIONS

Staff provides services to infants, children, and adults that reduce the incidence of vaccine preventable diseases in Oklahoma.

SOONERSTART

SoonerStart is Oklahoma's Early Intervention program for families of infants and toddlers, birth to 36 months, who have developmental delays. If your child is eligible for services, SoonerStart provides services where your child typically spends time: for example, home or childcare.

WIC

Program provides nutritious foods to supplement the diets of women, infants, and children. WIC offers information about healthy eating and promotes active lifestyles! WIC offers nutrition education in three formats:

- Online nutrition education
- Interactive, in person nutrition classes
- Private consultations with Registered/Licensed Dietitians (RD/LD).
