### About Us...

The Creek County (Sapulpa) Interagency, after a 15-year plus history, began a reorganization process in early 2010. By-laws were created and help to formalize the partnership. The group also changed its name to **Creek County Community Partnership Organization (C3PO)**.

Partnership agencies can be involved in several ways (1) Active or Voting members or (2) Supporting members. Currently, there are approximately 37 agencies represented in the partnership. With more agencies being represented in C3PO, the partnership's impact on Creek County is growing!

The partnership also began a strategic planning process. One of the strategies was to prioritize the goals of the partnership. This was done with the assistance of the Oklahoma Federation of Families. C3PO has traditionally focused on children- and youth-related issues, however, it has become important for the partnership to take a more comprehensive look at making children and youth more successful. The partnership has decided to focus on the family unit as well.

With significant reorganization of the partnership occurring, partnership members are celebrating these improvements and look forward to continuing to tackle priority areas in 2011.

### Significant Outcomes:

- ◆ Partnership Mission Statement developed and By-laws passed
- ◆ Social Host Ordinance passed in Sapulpa
- ◆ 24/7 Tobacco Free Policies were passed in Pretty Water and Allen Bowden. This makes 7 out of the 15 schools in Creek County 24/7 Tobacco Free.
- ◆ Resource Fairs held in April in conjunction with Child Link and in August in conjunction with healthy lifestyle promotion at the parks and Family Night.
- ◆ Forty at-risk youth attended Camp Hopeful Heart
- ◆ Creek County had an alcohol compliance check rate of 85.3% and this contributed 7.3% increase for the region
- ◆ Communities of Excellence in Tobacco Control awarded \$190,000 from TSET Board to continue Tobacco Prevention.
- ◆ Bullying Prevention Training for Area Schools
- ◆ Child Abuse Prevention Task Force District XI
