About Us...

Creek County (CC) is located in east-central Oklahoma. As of 2010, the population was 69,967. County seat is Sapulpa with a population of 20,544.

The Creek County Community Partnership (CCCP) was formed in 1993 as the CC Interagency. In 2006, after strategic planning with the support of agencies like Federation of Families and Sooner SUCCESS, the name was changed to Creek County Community Partnership to encompass all of Creek County services and agencies. In 2007, the CCCP sought a Systems of Care grant and became the SOC Community Team naming CREOKS Behavioral Health as the host agency for the \$120,000.00 grant.

Currently there are over 30 agencies represented in the partnership. The CCCP continues to serve as a valued resource for community partners and families.

Creek County Caregiver's Evening Out features a special time for caregivers to take the night off and get a much needed break from the stress of providing 24/7 caregiving duties. Over 50 Caregivers, family members and healthcare workers

were treated to an evening filled with food, fun, and information about the responsibilities of caring for a loved one. Information and education booths were set up by area healthcare and senior service organizations to offer resources for caregivers. Door prizes were donated by area vendors including the Creek County Health Department (CCHD), Creek County Ambulance, ONHL, Green Tree, and The Garden's.

The Strategic Prevention Framework/ State Incentive Grant has partnered with pharmacies, senior community centers, law enforcement agencies, home health services, and other community operations to increase awareness of the need for proper disposal of prescription drugs to avoid contamination of the environmental systems.

Working with law enforcement agencies, attention has been directed to the drug drop boxes in Bristow, Mannford, Sapulpa, and one installed in Mounds

Through various work groups and committees, the CCCP has tackled child abuse prevention, healthy lifestyles initiatives, drug and tobacco prevention and most recently has been collaborating with the Regional Outcome Epidemiological Workgroup to look at data affecting Creek County outcomes. The Coalition has participated in community events such as the Blue Ribbon Dash to raise awareness about child abuse

prevention and importance of healthy lifestyle. They have also participated in resource and transition fairs associated with area schools as well as assisted with activities in area schools during Red Ribbon week. This is a picture from the 2nd Annual Blue Ribbon Dash "Be A SuperHero for Kids" 5k and Fun Run sponsored by the CCCP. The event helped children and adults get moving while raising awareness of child abuse and neglect. The money raised from the event, over \$1200, will go towards child abuse prevention activities. CCCP helped



promote and plan the 2nd Annual Community Baby Shower with the CCHD.
