



About Us...

Delaware County Community Partnership (DCCP) is dedicated to improving the health and quality of life of citizens in Delaware County. Over the past year, the Partnership has focused efforts on formalizing board structure, revision of the by-laws and developing extended community partnerships. While reviewing the by-laws, the Board identified areas where clarification was needed and the idea of a membership agreement for agencies/partners was proposed. A new formal MOA, Memorandum of Agreement, was developed and adopted to allow for clearly defined guidance when partnering with other groups who may not have 501(c)3 status but are applying or planning to apply while working on programs or projects that coincide with the mission of DCCP.

Two groups have signed MOAs with DCCP this year, Delaware County

YES and Delaware County Bridges Out of Poverty. The Yes Program is a grant funded program that focuses on at-risk youth who find themselves in trouble with the law for the first time. This program utilizes



mentors and community volunteers working with law enforcement, the court system and the Office of Juvenile Affairs to help these youth get

back on track and supports them in those efforts.

Bridges Out of Poverty held the first Community Meeting in Delaware County in March 2011 and they developed a community focused steering committee, Delaware County Bridges of Hope. This group is operating on donated funds while developing a program and organizing fund raising and grant writing efforts. Both these partner organizations are doing much in Delaware County to improve the quality of life and health.

This year also saw a second annual effort of providing school supplies to children in need. The program was first started in 2010 with 500 children receiving supplies at the Grove Civic Center in July. Efforts, donations and partners increased this year and 725 children were able to get much needed supplies as well as attend a resource fair.
