Delaware County Community

Partnership (DCCP) is dedicated to improving the health and quality of life of citizens in Delaware County. Over the past year, the Partnership has focused efforts on achieving status as a Certified Health Improvement Organization (CHIO). Additional membership was recruited from under-represented community sectors and a strong CHIO board established. DCCP became a CHIO in June.

Through this process the coalition established a new partnership with INTEGRIS Grove Hospital. Members were able to assist the hospital in a community needs assessment and

development of a health improvement plan.



As the coalition grew, the need for more emphasis on development of effective organizational infrastructure became apparent. DCCP collaborated with the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth's Center for Community Based Initiatives to provide technical assistance in this regard. The group also worked to formalize board structure and revise current by-laws. While reviewing the by-laws, the Board identified areas

where clarification was needed and the idea of a membership agreement for agencies/partners was proposed. A new formal MOA, Memorandum of Agreement, was developed and adopted to allow for clearly defined guidance when partnering with other groups who do not have 501c3. DCCP serves as an umbrella agency for these organizations whose projects and programs align with the mission of the coalition.

The coalition is hopeful that the new CHIO designation will provide many exciting opportunities to better improve the health and lives of Delaware County residents.
