Medical Facilities Service, Plan Review Information Sheet: Self-Certification (Hospitals)

Applicable Rules (Oklahoma Administrative Code)

310:667-47-10. Self-certification of plans

310:667-47-1(e) [fees]

(2) Application for self-certification fee: One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00);

(4) Professional consultation or technical assistance fee: Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each eight staff hours or major fraction thereof. For technical assistance requiring travel, the fee may be increased to include the Department's costs for travel.

Projects Suitable For Self-Certification

- Building system upgrades
 - HVAC
 - Electrical
 - Plumbing
 - Access control systems
- Non-patient use support areas
 - Laboratory
 - Pharmacy
 - Kitchen/dining
 - Materials management
- Licensed areas that are Business Occupancies as defined by NFPA 101. These may be at the hospital address if appropriately separated, or at a remote location as allowed by 310:667-1-3(f)(2).
- Patient care areas that are considered basic care rooms, general care rooms or support rooms as defined by NFPA 99-2012 glossary paragraph 3.3.138
 - 3.3.138* Patient Care Room. Any room of a health care facility wherein patients are intended to be examined or treated.(MED)
 - 3.3.138.1* Basic Care Room. Room in which the failure of equipment or a system is not likely to cause injury to the patients or caregivers but can cause patient discomfort (Category 3). (MED)
 - 3.3.138.2* Critical Care Room. Room in which failure of equipment or a system is likely to cause major injury or death of patients or caregivers (Category 1). (MED)
 - 3.3.138.3* General Care Room. Room in which failure of equipment or a system is likely to cause minor injury to patients or caregivers (Category 2). (MED)
 - 3.3.138.4* Support Room. Room in which failure of equipment or a system is not likely to have a physical impact on patients or caregivers (Category 4). (MED)
